

Todd Everett has over 20 years of C-level and executive leadership experience in the supply chain, transportation, and logistics industry.

Mr. Everett joined Intel Corporation in 1996, and held a series of increasingly responsible positions in supply chain and logistics management over his 9 year career. Specifically, his final 5 years included the leadership of all North American distribution centers as well as leadership of Intel's transportation and 3rd party logistics networks for North and South America.

Following his role at Intel, Mr. Everett joined Newgistics in 2005. He served as President, CEO, and board member from January 2015 through May 2018. Mr. Everett led Newgistics through a period of rapid expansion and a successful sale to Pitney Bowes for \$475M. Prior to his role as CEO, Mr. Everett was COO/GM for 3 years and SVP/VP Operations prior to that. He oversaw all aspects of the company's facility and transportation networks and led the company's entry into small parcel delivery as well as the launch of fulfillment services in support of Newgistics' ecommerce customers. He successfully integrated 3 acquisitions, launched 11 new facilities, and during his tenure revenue grew by more than 10x. Currently, Mr. Everett is an active consultant, advisor, and investor with several emerging ecommerce focused logistics, technology, and retail companies.

Mr. Everett has been an active industry speaker and was invited to speak by the United States Congressional sub-committee on Postal Innovation. He is a recognized expert in many aspects of supply chain and logistics management including ecommerce logistics, 3rd party logistics, multi modal domestic and international transportation management, final mile delivery solutions, and logistics data and technology. Mr. Everett holds a Bachelor's degree in Transportation and Logistics Management from Iowa State University and previously sat on the university's Transportation Council.
